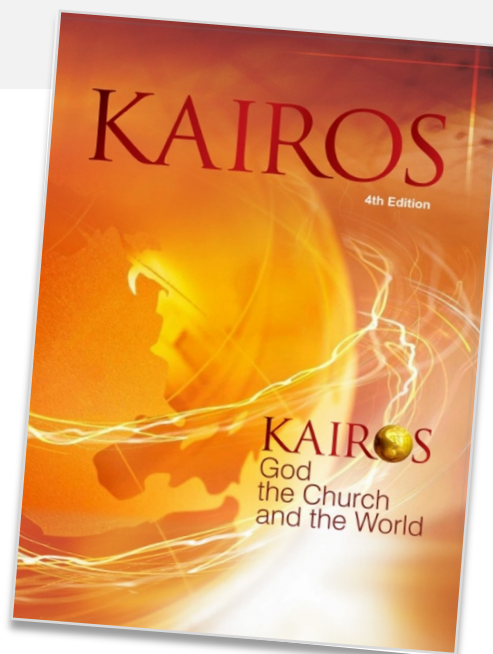

FORMAT:
